Causes of Black Smoke

Rich fuel mixture: Too much fuel in the air to fuel mixture can result in incomplete combustion, leading to the production of black smoke.

Clogged air filter: A dirty or clogged air filter restricts air flow causing an imbalance in the fuel to air ratio and potentially resulting in black smoke.

Fuel pressure: A faulty fuel pressure regulator can cause excessively high fuel pressure, resulting in a rich fuel mixture and black smoke.

Engine timing problems: incorrect ignition timing can disrupt the combustion process and lead to the production of black smoke.

Exhaust system restrictions: Blockages in the exhaust system, can cause black smoke due to poor exhaust gas flow.
